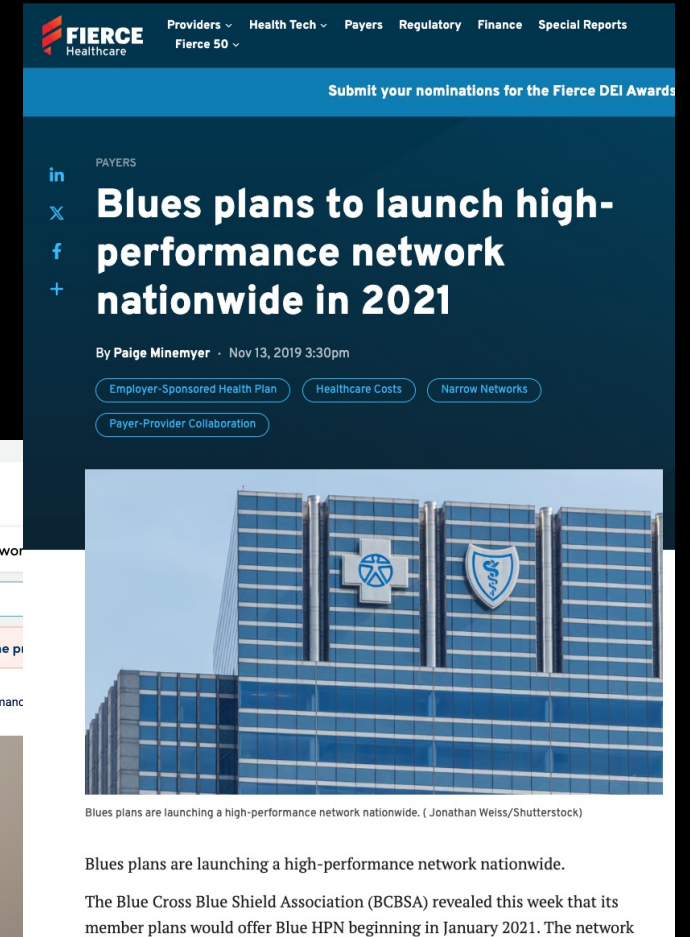
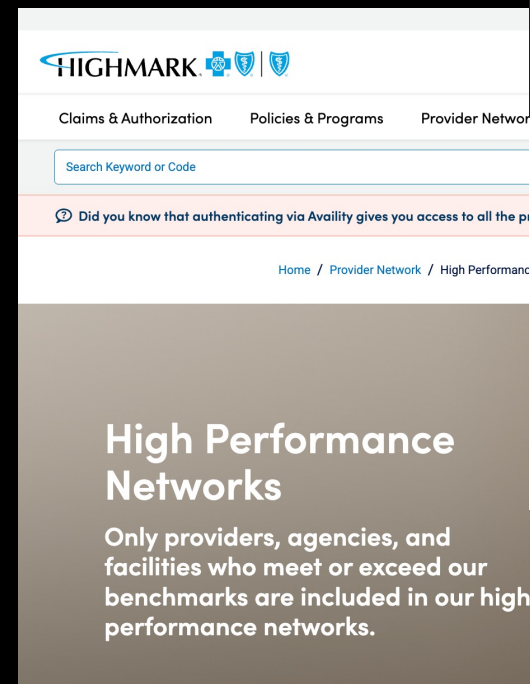
Many conceptual models frame varying definitions of healthcare success – reflecting the diverse stakeholders in the industry.



Organizations interpret high performing networks differently in the “wild”

“A curated network, built through data, technology, and partnerships with high value physicians, hospitals, ancillary providers, and other caregivers (brick and mortar, home-based, and virtual). These providers are deemed high performing based on their ability to consistently deliver high-quality, cost effective, member focused, collaborative care.”



The common thread of high performing networks:

1. Ensure access to sufficient care without adverse clinical outcomes
2. Provide an experience of care that provides even complex patients an experience of being known and respected
3. Provide access to the best care in the region

To facilitate this, high performing networks are **always** grounded in **data** and measurement.

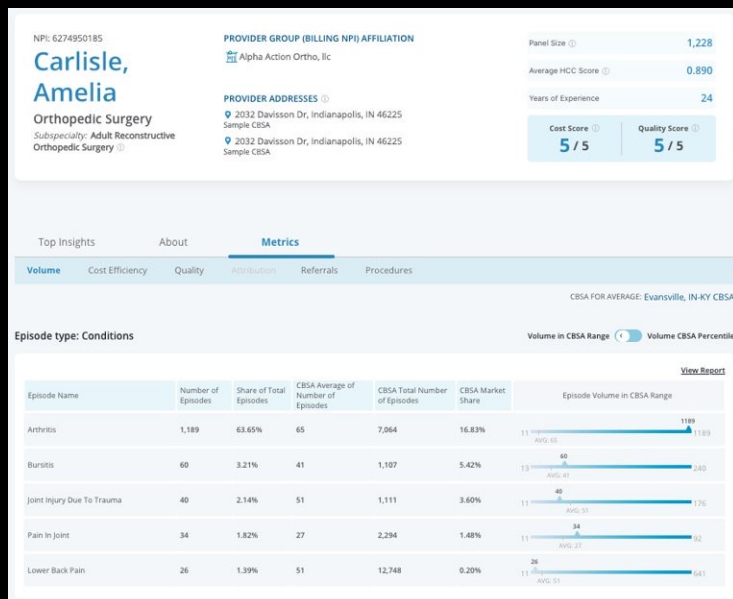
